**REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION INTO  
2012/2013 ACADEMIC SESSION**

**1.0 INTRODUCTION**

Federal University Wukari was established in 2011 along with other eight universities in the country to increase access to university education. Candidates applying for admission into the Federal University Wukari must show evidence of possessing the prerequisite qualifications before being admitted into various faculties and departments of the University.

**2.0 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

Admission into the university is open to candidates with the requisite qualifications. All applicants for admission into the University must attain sixteen (16) years of age; although provision is made for exceptionally gifted students.

The admission requirements into the undergraduate programmes for 2012/13 academic session are as follows:

- i. admission into the university is open to all irrespective of religion, ethnic group, gender, creed and disability;

- ii. all admissions into the university are through the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB);
- iii. for admission to 100 Level (via UTME), candidates must: obtain five (5) credits at SSCE (or equivalent) in relevant subjects at not more than 2 sittings including credit passes in English and Mathematics; and attain acceptable points in UTME in relevant subjects;
- v. credit passes in English Language and Mathematics shall be compulsory for admission into all programmes **EXCEPT** English and Literary studies and History and Diplomatic Studies where credit pass in mathematics is not required;

### 3.0 SPECIFIC FACULTY AND DEPARTMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the general requirements listed above, prospective students must satisfy the faculty and departmental requirements detailed below:
